RED WINES

FRANCE

La Croix Red Medium to full bodied Southern French wine, with a predominance of Carignan and Merlot grapes	5.99
Berrys House Red A light, Merlot based blend from the South of France, with a lingering dry finish	5.99
Berrys Good Ordinary Claret In traditional Claret style, this is a medium to full bodied blend of Merlot and Cabernet Sauvignon, with plenty of red & black fruits and ripe tannins	7.99
Cotes du Rhone Arnaud Grenache and Syrah grapes give this smooth, medium bodied wine a subtle, lightly spiced finish	11.99
Le Fume Pinot Noir A fruit driven wine, the Pinot Noir giving a pleasing light colour but with a fuller flavour than other French wines using this grape	8.99
Fleurie, Cave de Fleurie Made from the Gamay grape, a Beaujolais of distinction, light and fruity both to the nose and palate	10.99
Chateau Lamartre, St Emilion Grand Cru A stylish Bordeaux, medium bodied with hints of vanilla oak and a smooth, dry finish	16.50
Chateauneuf du Pape, St Jean Rich, full bodied Grenache with lots of depth	21.50

ITALY AND SPAIN

Villa Lucia Rosso	5.99
From Tuscany, this is a typical light Italian red wine from Sangiovese grapes, which give a pleasant earthy finish	
Montepulciano Orizzonti	7.99
The village of Montepulciano has its own named grape, which produces this light, pleasantly fruity wine	
Chianti Rufina Bascino	10.99
The best known of the Tuscan wines, again using the local Sangiovese grapes to give a smooth dry wine	
Castillo di Clavijo Tempranillo	6.99
The native grape of Rioja, the Tempranillo has gained popularity recently for producing light to medium bodied wines which, if unoaked as in this case, is easy drinking	
Castillo di Clavijo Rioja Reserva	10.99
From the same stable, but a well aged wine which has been matured in French oak barrels.	
Vinas de Gain, Artadi	19.99
In a more modern style, this Rioja achieves a light elegance whilst still retaining its local character. Artadi is a winemaker of considerable distinction	

THE AMERICAS

Palena Merlot	6.99
Chile has gained a well deserved reputation for its Merlot wines. This wine from the House of Valdivieso, is smooth and dry, with soft Merlot tannins	
Alamos Malbec	7.99
This sun-seeking grape has flourished in Argentina, and produces a deep coloured, velvety wine with ripe flavours	
Catena Malbec	14.99
Nicholas Catena is the king of Argentina's winemakers, and this superb, smooth dry wine is only one of his clutch of prized, award-winning wines. Hints of vanilla, ripe fruits and a long finish	

Au Bon Climat Pinot Noir 17.99
Californian wine legend, Jim Clenenden, makes this superb wine with a wonderful perfumed nose, pure red fruit and floral hints. No wonder the guys in 'Sideways' loved it!

Ridge Lytton Springs 25.00
Arguably the USA's top winemaker, Ridge excel with this medium to full bodied dry, red Zinfandel. Superb.

AUSTRALIA AND NEW ZEALAND

The Paddock Shiraz 5.99
No escaping the power and depth of this full bodied but smooth Shiraz, with its peppery spice.

Stump Jump by d'Arenberg 7.99
This Maclaren Vale wine is a blend of Grenache, Shiraz and Mourvedre; an intriguing, rich, spicy wine with lots of flavours

Deakin Shiraz 7.99
From one of Victoria's top wineries, the Deakin Shiraz is lively, spicy, yet still smooth and easy drinking

Madfish Cabernet Sauvignon/ Merlot 9.99
From the cooler climate of Western Australia, this wine balances the tannic power of Cabernet Sauvignon with the softer Merlot

High Trellis Cabernet Sauvignon 11.99
Great depth of fruit here. The warm South Australian climate brings out all the luscious quality of the Cabernet Sauvignon grape. Dark and delicious.

Spy Valley Pinot Noir 12.99
New Zealand is producing some of the world's best Pinot Noirs, although different in style to their French cousins. Slightly musty to the nose, this gives way to a beautiful fruit-driven wine

Dog Point Pinot Noir 25.00
Produced in tiny quantities by the former makers of 'Cloudy Bay' this is a particularly intense, dry but fruit-driven Pinot Noir. A winning combination.

WHITE WINES

FRANCE

La Croix White	5.99
A touch of Vermentino gives this light Sauvignon Blanc a more aromatic nose and spicy finish	
Berrys House White	5.99
Predominantly Chardonnay, this dry wine is enlivened with Mauzac and Vermentino but still easy on the palate	
Les Nuages Sauvignon Blanc	7.99
A Touraine from the Loire Valley, this is a clean, fragrant wine from the home region of Sauvignon Blanc	
Gewurtztraminer Ribeauville Prestige	11.99
The Alsace region produces this wonderful, aromatic grape which in this case gives a medium to full bodied wine with a complex, medium sweet finish	
Sancerre Andre Neveu	14.99
This small producer in the Loire still rates as one of the best examples of Sauvignon Blanc at its most fragrant, yet bone dry and lighter than those from the New World	
Petit Chablis Colombier	10.99
Far from being inferior to Chablis, this wine has more zest and freshness to it, still a dry Chardonnay but with a crisp lively style	
Chablis Colombier 1er Cru Vaucopin	17.99
A more complex, structured wine, with the full depth of Chardonnay giving the dryness of the wine subtle tones of peachy fruit	
St Veran Les Chailloux	12.99
One of the most full bodied burgundies, this brings out all the complex flavours of the Chardonnay grape with a deep straw colour and long finish	

ITALY AND SPAIN

Villa Lucia Bianco 5.99
This is a light Tuscan table wine, dry and with a fresh, crisp style yet easy on the palate and not too acidic

Pinot Grigio Orizzonti 7.99
A native of the Veneto region of Northern Italy, Pinot Grigio delivers a fresh, crisp acidity and in this example it is more full flavoured and deeper in colour

Alois Lageder Pinot Bianco 10.99
This vineyard is in the Italian Alps and makes dry, aromatic wines of which this is an excellent example. Elegant, pale and crisp with a clean finish

Alois Lageder Pinot Grigio Benefizium 16.99
A single Estate Pinot Grigio, with its Alpine freshness given much more complex aromatic quality by its concentrated flavours

Etim Montsant Blanc 8.99
An unusual white Grenache from the Catalan region near Barcelona, this is an excellent, dry wine with crisp, acidic fruit and a long finish

Albarino A20 11.99
Becoming popular along with Spanish food, the Albarino is a native of the Galicia region, and gives a wonderful aromatic, yet lively wine, dry but with flavours that dance around the palate

Allende Rioja Blanco 17.99
A unique blend of Viura and Malvasia grapes, this complex wine from the prestigious House of Allende is full flavoured, aromatic, with a hint of sweetness on the finish

THE AMERICAS

Palena Sauvignon Blanc 6.99
A good example of the fragrant, crisp Sauvignon Blanc which Chile has become renowned for. Lighter in style, with well balanced acidity

Alamos Chardonnay 7.99
This Argentine Chardonnay has a particularly clean, dry style which is unoaked, allowing the pure flavours of the Chardonnay grape to come through

Birichino Malvasia 13.99
Made by the former winemaker at the cult Californian producer Bonny Doon, this medium dry, aromatic wine is from the grapes used to make Madeira. It has a highly unusual mixture of flavours and aromas and can be enjoyed as an aperitif

SOUTH AFRICA

Montessin Chenin Blanc 5.99
A really excellent, value for money Chenin, which is really fragrant, medium dry with a clean, pure finish.

AUSTRALIA AND NEW ZEALAND

The Paddock Chardonnay/Semillon 5.99
An off-dry easy drinking white wine, with low acidity and a good accompaniment to most foods

Madfish Semillon/ Sauvignon Blanc 9.99
Medium dry, fragrance from Western Australia, giving a light, Bordeaux style but with a little more fruit

Spy Valley Sauvignon Blanc 9.99
An exceptional New Zealand Sauvignon Blanc, delivering clean fragrance without too much acidity. A lingering note of gooseberries and kiwi fruit and a pure dry finish

Wither Hills Sauvignon Blanc 9.99
Although a commercially targetted wine, this still delivers a consistent, pure fragrance with an off-dry note

Dog Point Sauvignon Blanc 13.50
A more complex, full bodied Sauvignon Blanc from the former makers of 'Cloudy Bay'. It delivers fragrance and flavour and, although dry, leaves a hint of sweetness on the finish

Spy Valley Riesling 9.99
The Riesling grape has flourished in the temperate New Zealand climate, and this medium dry example shows all the concentrated fruit you would expect without the cloying sweetness often found in German Riesling

Isabel Pinot Gris 12.99
Another grape which is finding success in New Zealand, and Isabel have used it well to make a dry, highly aromatic wine with complex flavours

ROSE WINES

Lamberti Pinot Grigio Blush 7.99
The Pinot Grigio grape acquires a softer character in its Rose form, and this easy drinking wine from Veneto is pure fruit, light and not too dry

Chateau d'Astros Rose de Provence 8.99
In its traditional 'Amphora' bottle, this Grenache based Rose from the South of France is bone dry, pale with a slight orange tone, light on the palate

Sancerre Rose Andre Neveu 14.99
Loire producers have successfully used Pinot Noir to make a light, fragrant rose, and this elegant wine is from our favourite House

CHAMPAGNE AND SPARKLING WINES

Champagne Bruno Paillard NV 35.00
As served on the 'Orient Express', this lovely champagne is lightly sparkling, with its hints of biscuit and pure grape. Paillard is a cult producer and this is a stylish wine

Champagne Roederer Brut NV 27.50
A lively champagne from one of Reims' traditional Houses. Dry and satisfying. 65% Chardonnay, 35% Pinot Noir

Prosecco Bisol di Valdobiedene	11.50
One of the best producers in Veneto, Bisol make a pure slightly aromatic, dry sparkling wine with a unique style	
Graham Beck Brut NV	10.99
This South African producer has won many awards with a fresh, very sparkling wine, with light elegant flavours and a dry finish	
Deakin Brut NV	9.50
Using a classic blend of Chardonnay and Pinot Noir, Deakin ensure that their sparkling wine stands above the many other 'Cavas' on the market.	

DESSERT WINES

Graham Beck Rhona Muscatel	9.99
With deep aromas of Muscat grapes, this is a full bodied dessert wine, sweet but not cloying, 16.5% alcohol	
Domaine Cauhape Jurancon 2005	9.99
A rich honeyed bouquet, with a refreshing citrus flavour and hints of apricot and peach. From the foothills of the Pyrenees	

SHERRY & PORT

Lustau Manzanilla Sherry	12.99
The lightest and driest of sherries, this makes a perfect Aperitif	
Lustau Medium Amontillado	12.99
On the dry side of medium, with a good oaked finish	
Fonseca LBV Port	13.99
Our most popular Port, not oversweet, but with a good aromatic lingering finish	
Quinto de la Rosa 2003	17.99
A full bodied vintage Port, with a rich deep ruby colour and a rounded sweet finish
